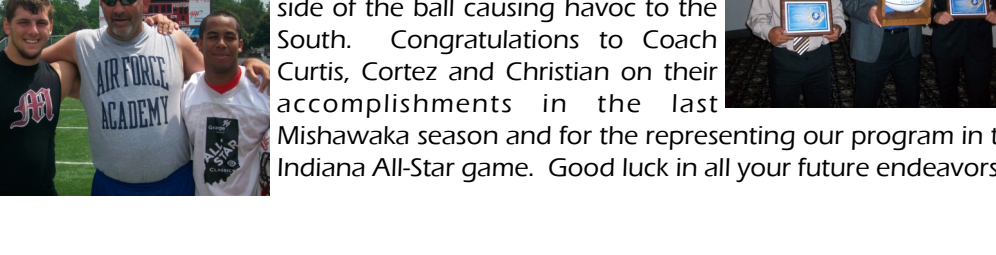
What does Mishawaka Football mean to me
